

## SUMMARY OF UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS 22-23

As a college prep high school with a professional work program, Cristo Rey Jesuit students embrace dressing for success and helping our school have a consistent and impressive appearance. All students must meet the below uniform expectations in order to remain enrolled. The full policy can be found in the student & family handbook.

Item	Details	Examples
1. Pants	Uniform dress pants in khaki, gray, or navy (Goldfish uniform pants strongly recommended). Dress pants must be worn at the waist, have belt loops, and may not have cargo pockets, metal studs, or chains.	
2. Shirt	CRJHS uniform shirt with CRJHS logo from Goldfish Uniform. Undershirts must be white, with no visible lettering or graphics. Young women may unbutton the top button only.	
3. Tie	Young men are required to wear a CRJHS uniform tie from Goldfish Uniform. Anyone wearing a tie must have the shirt buttoned to the top, the tie snug, and the shirt tucked neatly into pants with a belt.	
4. Socks	Young men are required to wear mid-calf or longer dress socks. Young women may wear dress socks or go without. Dress socks must be a solid, non-white neutral color (black, brown/khaki, navy, grey).	
5. Belt	Any person wearing a tie must wear a solid black, brown, or navy belt with a plain buckle.	
6. Shoes	Black, brown, or navy dress shoes. No open-toed shoes permitted.	

### Permitted options:

- One earring of moderate size (<1 inch) may be worn per earlobe.
- Uniform sweater or sweater vest from Goldfish Uniform.
- One modest necklace.
- Facial hair that is neatly groomed.

### Not permitted:

- Facial piercings, including rings or studs in the nose, lip, eyebrow, or tongue.
- Hair colors that are not naturally occurring, including bright red, pink, green, purple, blue, etc.
- Hair covering the face.
- Fingernails that interfere with typing, handwriting, or other school or CWSP tasks.
- Non-dress shoes, including Toms, Vans, Uggs, moccasins, huaraches, and athletic shoes.
- Non-uniform outerwear or accessories, including sweatshirts, jackets, buttons, hats, gloves, and scarves.
- Any designs or words carved into hair, visible tattoos, or visible stickers.

\*Note that the school and CWSP reserve the right to make final determinations about what does and does not meet the uniform expectations and students must meet any additional uniform requirements that their assigned CWSP partner has.
