Dear Cristo Rey Jesuit Parents and Students,

In our continued effort to keep you apprised of the measures we are taking to ensure student safety, we want to make you aware of our responses to two social media posts that were circulated over the weekend.

1. The first post involved an Instagram story in which an unidentified teen appeared to make a threat toward one of our students. Milwaukee Police have investigated this post and determined that it is a fake social media post that was created by a student. The police have confirmed, this post does not pose a threat to the Cristo Rey school community.
2. The second post featured a screenshot of an email that appeared to have been sent to Principal Bader on October 22, 2024 regarding Fernando Bustos. We have examined this post and confirmed that the email image contains neither an email address from the sender nor a subject line. In addition, we have confirmed that Principal Bader has no recollection of receiving the email.

Because of this, we engaged an external IT Consultant to audit Cristo Rey Jesuit's email data logs and records. **The initial report finds no evidence that the email featured in the post was received by Mr. Bader or anyone else at Cristo Rey Jesuit.**

Our primary concerns remain the interests of the victims and the preservation of evidence to support the criminal investigation. To this end, Cristo Rey Jesuit has retained legal counsel who is following up with Walter Garron, Noticias Wisconsin and El Conquistador Latino Newspaper to obtain more information regarding this social media, the email image featured in it, and where they obtained it. All information received in response will be shared with the District Attorney's office as we continue to collaborate with law enforcement.

Finally, we want to thank our families and students for your patience with the new security procedures that were implemented this morning. We understand that it may take a few minutes longer to get into the building, and we will continue to find ways to make this process run as efficiently as possible while still maintaining our high security standards. Thank you for trusting us with the safety and education of your children.
