This situation has been changing quickly, and we are continuing to share more information with you as it becomes available. As the Milwaukee Police Department continues its ongoing investigation into Fernando Bustos, police have informed us today that three additional Cristo Rey Jesuit female students have been identified on the video files they are investigating. Milwaukee Police reported to us that two of these students are fully clothed, and the third student was mostly clothed with no nudity. We have reached out to these students and their families. Throughout this entire process, Cristo Rey Jesuit stands in solidarity with our students and families to see that Fernando Bustos is brought to justice.

As part of our commitment to streamlining our communications with you and supporting transparency, we have created an information and resource page on our website at crjmke.org/faq. Cristo Rey Jesuit High School created this page so there is one easy place where you can find the information and helpful resources the school can provide to you during this difficult time.
